

# 2024-2025 Meal Prices

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) is a meal service option for schools and school districts in low-income areas and is a key provision of The Healthy, Hunger Free Kids Act (HHFKA, Public Law 111-296; December 13, 2010). CEP allows the nation's highest poverty schools and districts to serve breakfast and lunch at no cost to all enrolled students without the burden of collecting household applications.

*Schools qualify based on their percentage of direct certification. The term identified students refers to children who are directly certified for free school meals based on their participation (or a household member's participation) in other means-tested assistance programs, such as:*

- The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP),
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF),
- The Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) *Including Medicaid*

Participation in CEP will provide breakfast and lunch to ALL students at no cost.

Free and Reduced meal applications will not be submitted for the 24-25 school year.

**Second Meal prices for the 2024-25 school year are:**

\$1.75 for breakfast Students

\$3.00 for K-8 students

\$3.25 for High School students
