

2019-2020 Permission to Register for Career and College Promise

An opportunity that high school juniors and seniors have available is Career and College Promise (CCP) with Wilkes Community College (WCC). Students may take WCC classes during the course of the school day and receive both high school and college credit. College tuition is free; however, students will need to pay a fee of \$20 per class (includes text book).

Please remember that students will be taking college classes and will be treated as college students. Students must follow the college schedule and attendance policy while enrolled in WCC classes. Class attendance is directly related to student success. If a student stops attending class or decides to drop the class after the drop/add period, he/she will be given a withdrawal (W) grade at WCC and a failing (F) grade at Ashe County High School.

Attending Wilkes Community College is an exception to the regular high school day. Therefore, Ashe County High School requires a parent/legal guardian's signature in order for a student to register for any WCC class.
