2016-2017 Permission to Register for Career and College Promise

An opportunity that high school students have available is Career and College Promise with Wilkes Community College (WCC). Students may take WCC classes during the course of the school day and receive both high school and college credit. College tuition is free; however, students will need to pay a fee of \$20 per class. Students must follow the college schedule while enrolled in WCC classes.

In most cases, the student will be required to take college placement tests, these tests must be completed prior to the beginning of the semester.

Please remember that students will be taking college classes and will be treated as college students. If a student stops attending class, he/she will be given a Withdrawal Failing (WF) grade at WCC and a failing (F) grade at Ashe County High School.

Attending Wilkes Community College is an exception to the regular high school day. Therefore, Ashe County High School needs a parent/legal guardian's signature in order for a student to register for any WCC class.
