## DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR MIDYEAR GRADUATION

- 1. Student must fill out Part I completely.
- 2. The student's natural parents or legal guardian must fill out Part II.
- 3. The student takes the application to the Guidance Office after Parts I and II are completed. The Guidance Office will complete Part III and pass the application to the Assistant Principal who will verify the discipline records and indicate discipline infractions in part IV. The form will then be passed to the Principal.
- 4. After the application receives approval from the principal, the Guidance Office will notify the student and make arrangements to check schedules, etc., to assure all information is correct and processed.
- 5. The student and his/her parent/guardian must appear before the Ashe County Board of Education for final approval.
- 6. In all cases it is the student's responsibility to see that the application is completely filled out and returned to the proper office for processing. It is also the student's responsibility to be sure that the fall schedule is correct and that all necessary course work is successfully completed. All deadlines must be met for this application to be considered.
  - 1. Application must be submitted during second semester of the junior year.
  - 2. No student will be approved for midyear graduation prior to his or her 17<sup>th</sup> birthday.
  - 3. Student academic and attendance records should be well above average.
  - 4. Students discipline record should be clean.
- 7. A student who graduates early may choose to either participate in the next graduation ceremony or receive a diploma after the graduation ceremony. If the student elects to participate in the next graduation ceremony, it shall be the student's responsibility to attend all scheduled practices and related activities, which guarantee a smooth and efficient graduation process.
- 8. Students who graduate early may <u>not</u> participate in any second term activities except for the prom and the graduation ceremony.
  - \*Midyear Graduates who wish to participate in the prom and/or the graduation ceremony must follow the same protocol as students that are still enrolled in ACHS (dress code, dance code, prom date approval form)
