LOOKING FROM BEHIND THE "LENS" OF A VIDEOGRAPHER

We will cover:

- Logistics of shooting video: stable shots, camera's perspective, focus, placement of the subject in frame, proper lighting and audio
- Stylistic choices when editing: use of b-roll, voiceovers, adding music, text, and transitions

During the week, students will have opportunities to:

- Work on several job projects of their choice, including promotional videos for local businesses, short films, music videos, local news pieces, and short documentaries
- Plan out projects, film shots, and then edit everything together

Students will create and edit high-quality video content and explore careers involving audio and video production.


